**GEORGE J. PASQUARELLO, DO, FAAO, RE-ELECTED TO THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS
OF THE AMERICAN ACADEMY OF OSTEOPATHY**

Indianapolis, Indiana– March 31, 2011– George J. Pasquarello, DO, FAAO, was re-elected to a three-year term on the Board of Governors at the annual membership meeting of the American Academy of Osteopathy (AAO) in Colorado Springs, CO, March 16.

Dr. Pasquarello is a 1993 graduate of the University of New England College of Osteopathic Medicine (UNECOM), where he served a one-year Anatomy/Osteopathic Principles and Practices Undergraduate Teaching Fellowship prior to graduation. He is board certified in Neuromusculoskeletal Medicine (NMM) and Osteopathic Manipulative Medicine (OMM). Dr. Pasquarello served as Director of the NMM Residency and Co-Director of the Family Practice/NMM Residency at UNECOM from 1998 to 2003. He also worked as an Associate Professor of OMM at UNECOM, and as a clinical specialist at Maine Spine and Rehabilitation and University Healthcare. Dr. Pasquarello is currently in private practice at East Greenwich Spine & Sport in East Greenwich, RI. He is a member of the American Osteopathic Association House of Delegates, and a Past President of the American Academy of Osteopathy. He also serves on the AAO External Fundraising and Strategic Planning Committees and was recently elected President of the Foundation for Osteopathic Research and Continuous Education. He lectures to physicians and students at the national and international level on the application of OMM, myofascial pain and trigger point injection, prolotherapy and chronic pain management.
